

Vigilante leader killed in Kano

The police in Kano State have confirmed the death of a vigilante group leader, Mukhtar Garba Baballiya in Ja'en community, Gwale Local Government Area.

Reports revealed that the vigilante leader was stabbed on Tuesday night when he was trying to intervene in a dispute between thugs in Ja'en Makera and Ja'en Unguwar Lalle.

Daily Trust learnt that Baballiya was rushed to the Murtala Muhammad Specialist Hospital, where he was confirmed dead.

The police public relations

officer, Kano State command, SP Abdullahi Haruna Kiyawa, said one suspect had been apprehended in connection with the incident.

Kiyawa appealed to residents to report any threat to the police, assuring them that investigations were ongoing and the police remained committed to maintaining peace and security in the affected areas.

In recent times, violent clashes among thugs have become common in areas like Dorayi and Dala.
