

'One chance' robbers kill inspector in Abuja

A police inspector, Hussaini Umar, has reportedly been killed by suspected "one chance" robbers in Abuja in the FCT.

The victim, attached to the Force Intelligence Bureau, was said to have boarded the criminals' vehicle from the Maitama Junction along the Murtala Muhammad way, popularly on the Kubwa Expressway on his way home in Dei-Dei community.

Our reporter who visited the Kubwa General Hospital on Saturday morning, came across a police convoy, which went into the facility to convey his corpse, and headed to Zaria, Kaduna State, his home town, where it was billed for burial.

A police officer in the convoy, who did not disclose his name, said Umar was stabbed by the occupants of the vehicle before they dumped him around a bridge near the NNPC junction in Kubwa.

He said another vehicle ran over him before the police patrol team stationed around the junction was alerted and that the team took him to the hospital.

Another police source said the victim recently relocated his family to Abuja.

Contacted, the FCT Police Command's spokesman, SP Josephine Adeh, promised to make an inquiry and revert.
