

Building collapse kills 3 as violence, arson rock Jigawa

A building collapse incident and outbreak of violence and arson have rocked Jigawa State, leaving a trail of death and destruction in their wake.

In a statement, the police spokesman in the state, Lawan Shiisu Adam, said that the building collapse left three fatalities and four injured victims.

He said that in a separate incident, a suspected case of

rustling sparked a violent disturbance in the villages of Maikambu and Balalashe in Garki LGA leading to the burning of five houses and injuring six people.

He said the police had arrested two suspects in connection with the violence and were working to restore order in the affected areas.

He added that in order to prevent further breakdown of law and order, the command had called on individuals planning

to organise protests or to submit their itinerary to gatherings from August 1, the command.
