Gunmen kill students in Yobe

Gunmen suspected to be Boko Haram insurgents have killed students at Faudiya School in Geidam Local Government Area of Yobe State.

The school, affiliated with the Islamic Movement in Nigeria (IMN), a Shi'a sect, was attacked early Friday morning.

According to sources, the assailants invaded the Hausari quarters of Geidam LGA at around 3.44am, targeting the students while they were

sleeping. "They attacked the school, dragged the students outside and shot them dead," a witness said. The incident has caused widespread fear in the town.

A vigilante source confirmed that three members of the Shi'a sect were killed, and one person sustained injuries.

Yobe State Police Command's Public Relations Officer, DSP Dungus Abdulkarim, also confirmed the attack. He stated that the terrorists rode on motorcycles to carry out the assault.
