## 'Doctor' nabbed over death of patient in Nasarawa

he Nasarawa State
Police Command said it
has arrested a suspected
fake medical doctor who
injected procaine into a man
which led to his death.

The command disclosed this in a statement issued by its spokesman, DSP Ramhman Nansel, who said that preliminary investigation indicated that the suspect, whose level of education was Primary School Leaving Certificate (PSLC), claimed to have been trained at Asibitin Yusuf in Agyaragu in Obi LGA of the state.

He further said, "The fake doctor, named Isa Usman (35), had been operating in Iyayi

village, Kadarko District of Keana LGA. He was arrested for allegedly procuring and administering procaine injection on one Zaki Yaka Ajohol, which led to his death."

He added that the suspect confessed to having for the past three days procured and was administering procaine injection on his victim to treat typhoid. He further said, "On the fourth day, he administered the same dose of injection which made the victim become unconscious. He was rushed to the Primary Healthcare Centre (PHC) at Akeleku where he was confirmed dead. Consequently, some drugs and other medical implements were recovered from the suspect as exhibits."
