

Police Detain 2 Suspects For Allegedly Killing Man In Lagos

The Police in Lagos State says it has detained two suspects for allegedly killing a man, simply identified as Monday over alleged cable theft.

The command's spokesperson, SP Benjamin Hundeyin, said this in an interview with the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) on Monday in Lagos.

Hundeyin said that Alausa Police Division received information from a concerned member of the public about the case on Sunday at about 4pm.

He said, "The informant said that at about 3am of same date, he received a call from one of his brothers that one Monday has been lynched to death by some group of boys."

The PPRO said that the suspects and others still at large, conspired and murdered Monday after he was indicted for cable theft.

“After Monday was beaten to stupor, the suspects used copper wire to tie his neck and strangled him to death,” he added.

He said that the corpse had been recovered and evacuated to the morgue at Mainland General Hospital, Yaba, for preservation and autopsy, adding that investigation is ongoing. (NAN)
