

# How NDLEA official was burnt alive in Kaduna

An official of the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) identified as Aliyu Imran has been killed in the Igabi Local Government Area of Kaduna State.

According to SaharaReporters, Imran, an Assistant Superintendent of Narcotic 1, was burnt alive by an angry mob in the Gadan-Gayan area of Igabi LGA after a vehicle being pursued by the deceased and some of his colleagues was involved in an accident

that resulted in deaths.

"The officer and his colleagues were pursuing a suspected drug dealer when the suspect, in an attempt to escape, reversed his vehicle, killing at least three people on the spot," the platform reported.

Imran was said to have made an attempt to calm the situation when he was attacked by an enraged mob.

He was said to have been stabbed while the Officer in Charge (OC) called for backup.

A source said a brave

police officer rushed him to a nearby hospital, but the mob later stormed the facility, dragged him out and set him on fire.

His grieving family has accused the NDLEA of failing to issue a statement or reach out to them for condolences or compensation.

While confirming the incident, NDLEA spokesperson, Femi Babafemi, denied the allegation that the agency does not care about officials who die in the line of duty.
