Suspected Robber Dies After **Mob Attack**

The Police Command in Lagos State has confirmed that a suspected armed robber died in the hospital after being rescued from an attempted lynching.

The command's spokesperson, CSP Benjamin Hundeyin, disclosed this to newsmen on Monday in Lagos.

He stated that the incident occurred on Saturday at Akerele Junction in the Agege area of the state.



"On March 15, a distress call was received at Isokoko Division about a suspected armed robber who specialised in snatching mobile phones from commuters.

"The suspect was apprehended and beaten to a stupor by an angry mob, who were on the verge of lynching him," Hundeyin said.

He added, "Upon receiving the report, police teams were swiftly deployed to the scene. The mob fled upon sighting the police.

"The suspect, who had sustained severe injuries, was rescued and rushed to the hospital for treatment, where he later died," the police spokesperson added.

He said that preliminary investigations revealed that the deceased and his accomplices, currently at large, allegedly stabbed a middle-aged woman and dispossessed her of her phone. (NAN)
