The Kano State Police Command has detained a 20-year-old suspect from Sharifai Quarters in connection with the alleged killing and attack on vigilante members at the **Emir Palace.**

The command's spokesperson, SP Abdullahi Kiyawa, disclosed this on Sunday in Kano.

He said the incident occurred during the entourage of Emir Sanusi Lamido Sanusi II Eid prayers on Sunday.

Kiyawa said the suspect, along with others currently at large, allegedly stabbed Surajo Rabiu, a vigilante member from Sabon Titi Jaba Quarters, who later succumbed to his injuries.

"Another vigilante member, Aminu Suleman of Kofar Mata Quarters, sustained injuries and is receiving treatment at Murtala Mohammed Specialist Hospital, Kano.

"The police have launched an investigation and invited Shamakin Kano, Alhaji Wada Isyaku, for questioning."

The command reaffirmed its ban on all forms of Durbar celebrations, warning that violators would face decisive action. NAN
