

Lakurawa kills 2 fishermen, 1 farmer in Sokoto

Suspected members of the Lakurawa armed group have killed two fishermen and a farmer in an attack on Sanyinna village in Tangaza Local Government Area of Sokoto State. attacks were reported in the neighbouring villages of Sutti and Takkau within the same local government area, where two individuals sustained gunshot injuries.

The attackers, who reportedly rode in on multiple motorcycles from a nearby forest, struck around 11 am on Tuesday.

The victims have been identified as Zubairu Kusugu, Aminu Ibrahim, and Salisu Dangwati.

Local sources said the victims were engaged in their regular fishing activities when the assailants ambushed them, cutting their lives short in a brutal assault.

Confirming the incidents, Garzali Raka, Special Assistant on Security to the Tangaza Council Chairman, said the assailants also stole several livestock including cows, camels, sheep, and goats during Monday's attacks.

When contacted, the spokesman of the Sokoto State Police Command, DSP Ahmed Rufai, confirmed the incident.

He said the command is actively pursuing the attackers and vowed that they will be brought to justice in no distant time.
