Niger: Bandits kill vigilantes, demand more money after killing hostage's wife

Two vigilantes were killed and another injured during a gun battle with bandits in Wamba, Mariga LGA of Niger State.

According to local sources, confrontation are the heavily armed bandits, pending. In a related motorcycles, were intercepted bandits have killed a by vigilantes, resulting in the casualties.

The Mariga LGA chairman, Abbas Kasuwan Garba, said the injured vigilante is receiving treatment, and joint security forces have been deployed.

The state Commissioner for Homeland Security, Brig. Gen. Bello Abdullahi

(rtd), confirmed the bandits' movement and said security forces are pursuing them, though full details of the confrontation are still pending.

In a related incident, bandits have killed a woman named Lami, who was abducted along with her husband, Yakubu Dada, in October 2024 on Kontagora Road.

It was learned that despite collecting a N10 million ransom in November, the captors are now demanding an additional N20 million and four Bajaj motorcycles.
