
## Boko Haram Kills 4 In Adamawa Community

Suspected Boko Haram insurgents have attacked and killed four people, while others sustained injuries in Wagga Mongono community of Madagali Local Government Area of Adamawa during a late-night raid on Tuesday.

Eyewitnesses said that the suspected insurgents stormed the village with guns, shooting sporadically under the cover of darkness before setting shops and a church ablaze.

An eyewitness disclosed to this medium that residents fled into nearby bushes, abandoning their belongings in a desperate bid to stay alive.
