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TWO KILLED IN SHEDA VILLAGE AUTO CRASH

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Two persons lost their lives while four others sustained serious injuries on Friday night at Sheda village, along the Abuja-Lokoja highway.

Our reporter learnt that the two victims, while been taken to the hospital by the rescue officials of the Federal Safety Commission (FRSC).

A witness said the accident happened when the driver of a Golf car with registration number LND 304 BC, lost control on top speed and the car somersaulted before crashing into a ditch.

When contacted, Yangoji unit commander of the FRSC, Austine Chukwudi Okeke, confirmed the accident which he attributed to speed violation, saying two of the victims died while been taken to Kwali General Hospital.

He said the two corpses have been handed over to the deceased relatives for burial while the four injured victims have been taken to Kwali General Hospital for medical attention.

He further disclosed that five persons were also injured in another accident which occurred last Thursday morning at Sabon-Gari village, along the Abuja-Lokoja highway. The FRSC commander said the accident happened around 7:15 am when a Volkswagen Golf with registration number KSF 95 AX, had tyre burst on speed and plunged into a ditch, saying the five injured victims including three children were taken to Kwali General Hospital.

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
