Two killed as robbers swoop on Union bank

There was pandemonium in the early hours of yesterday when about 18 armed robbers invaded the Oshodi branch of Union Bank and killed two mobile policemen who were on guard at the bank.

The robbers, who were said to be armed to the teeth with sophisticated weapons, it was gathered, stormed the bank's premises

es in a convoy of six vehicles, a red Toyota Carina E and five Kombi buses all painted white.

The robbers, in their usual style, were said to have broken into the bank's premises and had tied the security men down before shooting sporadically in to the air to scare away passers-by. They were said to have shot the two mobile

policemen as they allegedly made moves to seek help from other colleagues.

A source told Daily Times that the robbers stormed the bank with full complement of welders and electricians with power generating sets with which they found their way into the banking hall after breaking security barriers at the bank.
