

Four die in Oyinlola campaign train

The re-election campaign of Governor Olagunsoye Oyinlola of Osun State suffered a setback on Tuesday following the death of four members of his team in a ghastly motor accident that occurred at Ipetu Ijesa.

Eye witnesses told Daily Times Nigeria that nine other persons were seriously injured in the accident, which occurred along Jagbaja/Ile Oluji road.

The witness said the accident involved a bus and a reticulated vehicle popularly called trailer.

The trailer, according to the witness, ran into the campaign train of the governor on their way to Ipetu Ijesa in Oriade Local Government council of the state killing four persons instantly.

It was gathered that the trailer, which was coming in the opposite direction, lost control and rammed into the governor's convey.

The incident threw the PDP camp into mourning as party supporters wept uncontrollably.

Once informed of the incident, the governor directed that the rally be cancelled and made his way to visit the injured who were taken to Wesley Guild Hospital in Ilesa.

He later paid a condolence visit to the families of the dead.
