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10 die in motor accident in Katsina

About 17 other people sustained various degrees of injuries in the crash

Ten persons were killed on Wednesday in a ghastly motor **accident** at Abukur Village along **Katsina-Kano Road**.

Witnesses say the **accident** occurred at about 4 p.m.

The **accident** involved a Toyota Corolla car, with registration number AG 54 SRP, and 18-seater commercial bus, with registration number XF 401 KTN.

The bus, which was coming from Katsina, had a head-on collision with the vehicle coming from the opposite direction while overtaking at a bend.

All the six occupants of the Toyota car, including an army officer,

and four occupants of the bus died on the spot while others sustained injuries.

Tartius Haziel, of the Federal **Road** Safety Corps, said about 17 persons got injured and were taken to the General Hospital in Katsina. He said that the 10 corpses had been deposited at the hospital mortuary.

Haziel, who attributed the **accident** to wrong overtaking, called on drivers to always obey traffic rules and regulations.



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
