

Armed robbers kill middle-aged man in Lagos

LAGOS—A middle-aged man, Yemi Ogunbayo, was on Sunday found dead by the police at Ilasan, Epe Expressway, a suburb of Lagos State. The victim who left his house on Saturday was reportedly found dead at about 12noon on Sunday.

Mr Ogunbanjo who resides at Ajiran Town Lekki, having had a pleasurable day with his family, left his home to visit another friend unknown to him that he will not have the opportunity to meet them again.

Cityscope gathered that, the deceased, unknowingly boarded

an unmarked bus filled with armed robbers who were on the prowl for victims. According to an eyewitness, the robbers reportedly matcheted him after robbing him of his belongings and threw him out of the vehicle.

After waiting for her husband to return, Mrs Idowu Ogunbanjo, wife of the deceased went to report at the State Criminal Investigation Department (SCID), but she was shocked to learn that her long-awaited husband had been murdered.

The Police spokesman, Mr Olubode Ojajuni who confirmed in his Oduduwa Office said the corpse had been removed to the public mortuary for autopsy and the case is under investigation.
