At the Ibadan North Local Government, a serving member of the House, Tayo Sarumi alleged being rigged out and accused the Deputy Governor, Alhaji Azeem Gbolarumi of aiding in the electoral fraud. While accusing the Deputy

that the results were doc-

tored to favour Gbolarumi's

candidate, Waheed Gbede.
