PARADED ROBBERS: NO fewer than 59 armed robbers were yesterday paraded by the Lagos State Police Command at the states' Criminal

Investigation Department (SCID), Panti, Yaba, Lagos. The robbers, paraded by the Lagos State Commissioner of Police, Emmanuel Adebayo included those who raided Alaba Market, killing

eight persons, and fraudsters.
One of the Alaba bank robbers, Sunday Chukwu, who spoke with The Guardian, said: "I had stopped armed robbery job, this last one was the one I joined them to do. I did not enter the bank,
