

# Gunmen kill two in Port Harcourt

**G**UNMEN suspected to be members of one of the notorious gangs in Rivers State jostling for supremacy attacked and killed two persons in Port Harcourt at the weekend.

*The Guardian* gathered from eyewitnesses that this latest confrontation was between members of the Outlaws Group and their archrival, the Icelanders. The strike is said to be a reprisal on the Icelanders.

*The Guardian* learnt that two gunmen drove a Honda IVETC to the residence of an alleged commander of the Icelanders, Naz, at Oke Street, Ogbunabali, Port Harcourt.

As soon as the gunmen arrived at the house, they reportedly opened fire on two young men. According to neighbours who pleaded anonymity, the gunmen fired several shots at their victims and ensured that they were dead before leaving the scene.

The gunmen's actual target was said to be Naz who probably got wind of the impending attack and so decided to run away before the arrival of the gunmen, who missed him.
