Robbers kill man, steal N15m jewellery in Kano

ROBBERS, at the weekend, stormed the Hajj Camp in Kano, stealing jewellery estimated at N15 million.

The thieves, numbering not less than 10, also shot and killed a commercial motorcyclist, popularly called Okada.

According to a witness' account, the robbers initially parked their three vehicles, conducted surveillance for about 10 minutes, before unleashing a reign of terror on

their defenceless victims.

Among the victims were Hajia Magajiya, Alhaji Muhammadu Sani, who were taken unaware by the robbers who had come to the camp on the pretext of shopping for jewelleries

and personal wears.

Death was, however, beckoning to the Okada man who unfortunately ran into the thieves while the robbers where fleeing along the nearby airport road of the metropolis.

One of the robbers who was aware of the implication of being caught in their act was said to have immediately brought out his gun and shot the Okada rider in the head. He died on the way to the Murtala Muhammed Hospital.

The Kano State Police Command spokesperson, Alhaji Baba Muhammed, confirmed the incident and said the police have begun investigation into the matter.
