Six feared dead, five missing in Cross River, Anambra flood

SIX persons are feared dead in Yahe, Yala Local Council of Cross River State following a week downpour that rendered thousands of persons homeless.

Sources in the community said the death toll could be higher as the community was still taking stock of the disaster.

Farm crops and residential houses were washed away in the incident, which rendered several people homeless.

The Clan Head of Edibia in Yahe kingdom, Chief Ogiamode Ipuole, has already sent a rescue message to Governor Liyel Imoke.

Ipuole also solicited the help of the State Emergency Relief Agency (SEMA), to help the victims of the flood with relief materials.
