Police arrest seven over doctor's death

THE Edo Police Command says it has arrested seven persons in connection with the death of a female medical doctor

found dead in her home in GRA, Benin, about a week ago.

Her throat was slit and she

was tucked away under her bed to die, according to a police report at the weekend. The motive for her killing

is unknown, but her husband, who was away abroad, was expected to arrive on the day she was murdered.

According to relations of the 29-year-old woman, the house-help, a male, claimed that a mysterious man named Michael came calling on the fateful day and was allowed into her living

room.

The house-help reportedly told the relations that he was away on an errand for the dead woman when her killing occurred.

Police spokesman, Peter Ogboi, said the Police have been to the scene of incident and had arrested seven persons in connection with it. Meanwhile, the state
