ARRESTED: On October 24, at about 2:25am, a team of anti-robbery policemen from Denton Police Station, acting on information, arrested the duo of Tunde Idowu of No 89, Borno Way and Adewale Sikiru of No. 8, Kano Street, all in Ebute Metta. The suspects, armed with cutlasses, robbed one Mrs. Sarah Walabo of her handbag, containing valuables, along Borno Way, Ebute-Metta. The robbed bag was later discovered on the suspects. Similarly, on October 23, at about 10pm, a team of anti-robbery policemen from RRS, Alausa received information that occupants of a Green Nissan, with Reg. No. AE 465 RSD and Isuzu Bus, Reg. No. XE 559 BDG, were suspected to be armed robbers. The police team trailed the vehicles to Yaba Bus-Stop and on noticing the Police, the occupants jumped out and took to their heels. Two of the occupants were chased and arrested. These are Dada Tijani of 18, Abiri Ikoyi Street and Opeyemi Ahmed of Agbole Alamo Compound, Isokan, Osun State. During search of the vehicles, one cutlass, a handbag and assorted wearing apparels were recovered. The suspects have made useful statements.
