

Six Feared Killed As Hoodlums Clash In Oshodi

BARELY one month after the Chairman of the National Union of Road Transport Workers (NURTW), Lagos State chapter, Alhaji Saka Saula was murdered by gunmen, another war of supremacy was re-enacted in Oshodi area yesterday, claiming six lives.

The Oshodi fracas started around 3am and continued till 2pm despite the heavy presence of armed mobile policemen.

The Guardian sighted lifeless bodies of some of the victims, who were also suspected to be gang members at the Makinde Police station, where the police later took them to, before they were deposited at the Ikeja General Hospital mortuary.

During the clash, police arrested no fewer than 20 of the street urchins, otherwise known as Area Boys.

Many of them with bullet and machet wounds are now being detained at the Makinde Police Station on the orders of the Commissioner of Police, Alhaji Mohammed Abubakar.
