Four die as building collapses in Ogbomoso

NO fewer than four persons were feared dead at the weekend and many others injured in Ogbomoso when a two-storey building under construction collapsed.

The incident, which occurred at Under G area of Ladoke Akintola University of Technology (LAUTECH), came on the heels of an earlier five one months ago when the Pharmacy section of the teaching hospital currently being constructed by the Oyo State government collapsed and killed some workers on site.

The collapsed building, it was gathered, was a subject of dispute between one Saka and an Abidjan, Cote d'Ivoire-based businessman named Olayiwola Raymond.

The duo were said to be business partners until things went awry between them forcing them to part ways.

Although the cause of their disagreement could not be ascertained, it was learnt that Raymond had taken over the building that was being built by Saka for his personal use.

Raymond's action was said to have infuriated his estranged friend who vowed to fight back, claiming that the house belonged to him.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Olabisi Okuwobi, stated that only three persons were confirmed dead while three others were rescued alive.

His words: "I have just spoken with the Area Commander in Ogbomoso and he confirmed the incident to me. Only three persons were dead while another three were rescued alive. The injured ones are still on admission at the hospital".
