Three family members die in Gombe inferno

MYSTERIOUS fire on Tuesday night in Gombe, Gombe State, claimed the lives of Mr. Femi Balogun, 42; his wife Adenike, 33 and their five-year-old son, Martins, in the family home at the

Federal Low-cost Housing Estate. According to neighbours

According to neighbours who tried to rescue the victims but were thwarted by strong burglary installations at the two-bedroom

apartment, the fire broke out at about 9.45p.m and raged for over an hour during which the family members woke up but were too confused to make good

their escape from the inferno.

The blaze also spread to an adjourning three-bedroom apartment, which it also consumed but thankfully without any further

fully without any further loss of lives.

The cause of the fire still remained unknown.

Mr. Joel James Radakson, first son of the apartment owner, said his attention was drawn to the incident some minutes to 10 p.m. when someone called out his name after a sudden noise and huge smoke filtered out of the victims' flat.

Radakson said before he could alert his mother, the landlady and other occupants of their apartment, it was also swiftly covered in thick cloud of smoke from the Balogun family flat.
