Man dies in Rivers cult clash

AT least, one person was feared killed and three others seriously injured on Monday in a clash between two notorious cult groups in Port Harcourt, Rivers State.

The Guardian gathered that the clash, which occurred along the rail-line near Station Bus Stop in Port Harcourt, began at about 11.00 p.m. on Monday night.

While the cause of the fight could not be ascertained yesterday, a resident of the area, Benson Uduak, said the development might not be unconnected with the failure of the amnesty programme, which according to him, had left the former militants idle.

He lamented that the amnesty programme has cooled off since the absence of President Umaru Musa Yar'Adua.

Rivers State Police Public Relations Officer, Mrs. Rita Innoma-Abbey, who confirmed the incident, said the police moved to the scene immediately they got the information and discovered a dead body and three injured persons there.

Innoma-Abbey disclosed that seven suspects have been arrested and were being interrogated over the incident.
