## **Police parade octogenarian, 11 others for rape, murder, kidnapping**

**TWELVE** suspects were yesterday paraded by the **police** in Ekiti State in connection with **murder**, robbery and **rape** in the state.

The **Police** Commissioner, Mr. Chris Katso, who paraded the suspects at the state **police** command, gave their identities as Jonathan Adesoye (82), who was arrested with one Tijani Adeniyi for raping a 13-year-old girl at Idolofin area of Ado-Ekiti, Segun Omoju and Oluwole Adedara, alleged to have been terrorising the residents of Ogbon-Oba in the state capital.

While Adesoye denied his involvement in the crime, Adeniyi was said to have confessed to the crime, which the **police** boss said is still under investigation.

They were arrested by a team of policemen after a tip-off on their activities by a resident who was beaten up by the suspects.

Katso said the suspects had attacked and robbed the resident and members of his household of their valuables. They were also alleged to have raped two of his younger sisters, aged 17 years and 19 years.

He said the hoodlums, after carrying out their nefarious activities, took to their heels but were later over-powered by **police** patrol team that arrested them.

The **police** chief explained that the stolen items were recovered from the suspects, adding that one machete recovered at the scene of the crime was registered as exhibit.

↓ Katso also paraded one Asekeme Gift, who was arrested in connection with the **murder** of one Kola Adeyemi, a 100 level student of the University of Ado-Ekiti.

He said the suspect was arrested following information that suspected members of a secret cult armed with guns, charms, bottle and axes invaded Adebayo area of the state capital and killed the victim.

The **police** further disclosed that one Nifemi Olowoniyeye of Igede-Ekiti was arrested after a tip-off over attempted **kidnapping** of the daughter of one Kobomoje.

The suspect was alleged to have threatened the family of Kobomoje to pay a ransom of N200,000 or have their daughter kidnapped.

Five other suspects were also paraded for the alleged **murder** of a **Police** Constable, Shaibu Momodu, at Irele-Ekiti **police** post. They are Buba Kanti, Da Aliu, Buba Aliu, Mohammed Tukur and Mohammed Bello Mamman.

The suspects, who were identified as Fulani herdsmen, were also accused of killing two Tiv brothers, Udah Benjamin and Udah Mathew, who had reported at the **police** post on the destruction of their farm products by the suspects.

The last suspect, Hammed Ajise, was arrested by the **police** during a stop-and-search order by men of the command who found 21 handsets on him allegedly stolen from his victims. He said the suspect confessed to the **police** that he stole the handsets from their owners.
