

Man Beats Wife To Death Over Phone Call

Aman has reportedly beaten his wife to death over a telephone call yesterday at their 3, Oguntade Street residence off Agric Road, Igando Egan, Lagos.

The man, Emmanuel Adun, an Edo State indigene, allegedly beat his 51-year-old wife, Paulina to stupor after she refused to disclose the identity of her caller.

Thinking that she was pretending to be in a coma, Adun allegedly left her in the state for over four hours before

realizing she was actually in a coma.

He rushed her to hospital but it was rather too late to revive her. The doctor confirmed her dead. Having confirmed her dead, Adun took her corpse home, dropped her at the steer case and took to his heels.

One of the neighbours, Comrade Obatomiwa Odusanwo who spoke to *The Guardian* said an argument ensued over the identity of the person who called Paulina, leading to the beating.

"We actually got informed after the deed had been done.

It was her daughter, Favour, who related how it all started to us. She informed us around 3.am and we informed the police after calling the landlord.

We reported the case to the Igando Police Station and they sent five policemen with their vehicle to the scene," Odusanwo said.

Although the DPO Divisional Police station Igando Mr. Gbenga Adeoye declined to comment on the matter, a policeman who preferred anonymity, confirmed the incident to *The Guardian*.
