Flood kills two, destroys property in Katsina

HEAVY downpour in some parts of Katsina State has claimed the lives of two people while properties worth millions of naira were destroyed.

Also, about 500 people have been rendered homeless in some local councils in the

state.

In Dutsima, property worth millions of naira were lost to the flood while about 70 houses were submerged, leaving about 120 people homeless. At Tudun Gada and Ungwar Tukura, two people lost their lives leaving no fewer than 200 people homeless.

Expressing his deep sympathy to the victims of the disaster, Governor Ibrahim Shehu Shema, who was accompanied by some members of the state executive council, commended the local councils areas for providing the victims with necessary relief materials and temporary accommodation as well as alternative arrangement to supply them with clean and potable water.

While inspecting the area, the governor assured the victims of his immediate assistance
