THERE seems to be no end **1** to the shooting in Plateau State as suspected gunmen on Thursday attacked and killed five people in Jos South Council of the state.

The incident occurred at about 7.30 p.m. Thursday when some alleged armed men stormed the premises of Federal College of Land Resources Technology, Vom, and started shooting sporadically with a view to rustling

cows within the premises. A source close to the College said that the suspect-

ed gunmen killed the Chief Accountant of the College. Mr. Audu Chobe, his wife and their three-year old daughter in their sleep.

It was further learnt that the assailants who were said to be 20 in number also snuffed life out of the college's electrician simply identified as Hosea and Chief Security Officer, Mr. Haruna Daniuma and rustled his 30 cows within the

vicinity. Those within the vicinity further said that nine people within the college and nearby residential houses sus-
