

Gunmen kill police inspector in Borno

A POLICE Inspector was shot and killed by two suspected Boko Haram gunmen on a motorcycle on Wednesday in Dala Ward of Maiduguri, Borno State.

The event came on the heels of new security measures announced in the state by the Chief of Defence Staff (CDS), Air Chief Marshal Oluseyin Petinrin, who visited Government House, Maiduguri earlier on the same day.

The motorcycle-riding assassins trailed the police officer to his house at about 5p.m where they shot and killed him at a close range.

Borno Police Commissioner, Mohammed Abubakar, confirmed the killing.

He said: "We received a distress call from the Dala police post that one of our officers was gunned down by the two suspected Boko Haram gunmen on a motorcycle at his Dala residence."

Abubakar said no arrests have been made in relation to the incident, but assured that the assassins would be nabbed using the information provided by eyewitnesses at the scene.
