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Six Feared Dead In Crash

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No fewer than six people were feared dead while others sustained serious injuries in a ghastly motor accident yesterday morning in Obada-Oko town, Ogun State.

The accident, which occurred between Obada-Oko and Obasanjo Farms on the Lagos-Abeokuta Expressway, involved three trailers, a car, a commuter bus and two tipper lorries, which completely blocked a side of the ever-busy road, leading to heavy traffic jam.

Reports have it that the accident, which occurred around 2:am, was between two trailers. The first one was carrying bags of flour and the other cows but the other five vehicles unfortunately rammed into them.

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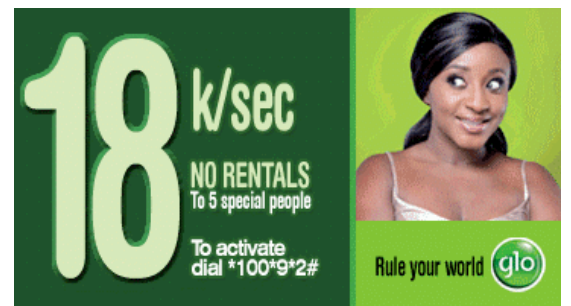
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
