

Four feared killed in Port Harcourt robbery

DARE devil bandits led by a female yesterday killed four persons including a police sergeant and carted undisclosed sum of money in Port Harcourt.

The gang which was made of two female and three

male ambushed a Jetta Volkswagen, conveying goods, belonging to Multinet Communications-GSM recharge cards dealers as it tried to drive into Zenith Bank on Rumuola Road, Port Harcourt.

An eyewitness explained that having successfully

intercepted the vehicle, two of the female robbers swiftly alighted from their own vehicle and opened fire on the victims.

The source who declined to reveal his name said he suspected the robbers must have been informed of the

movement of cash to or from the bank.

"The leader of the gang is a woman, she was the one who pulled the trigger on the people in the car and carried the money they had with them. It took them about ten minutes to kill, rob and escape from the

spot. They went through NTA Road," he said.

The Rivers State Commissioner of Police, Suleman Abba, who grieved over the incident, admonished individuals and companies to always keep their financial transactions as private as possible.
