One feared killed as hoodlums clash in Lagos

BARELY a week after a clash claimed two lives on Lagos Island, another life was feared lost yesterday at the Sangre area of the Island as suspected miscreants carried out a reprisal attack.

The Guardian gathered that the hoodlums were retaliating the death of one of their members who was said to have been killed by another group recently.

Scores of persons were said to have been injured during the clash, which lasted for hours.

The crisis also spread to places like Okesuna and Lafaji areas of the Island.

It was gathered that calm was only restored to the area when a detachment of policemen was deployed to the scene of the clash.
