## Police kill suspected bank chief's abductors

**N**EMESIS yesterday caught up with two kidnap suspects who allegedly abducted the Osogbo branch manager of a new generation bank, Mr. Adeyemi Adeniji, as the police in Osun State shot them dead.

Adeniji was said to have been kidnapped in front of his house in Ile Ife, Osun State on Wednesday when he was returning from work by seven men and a woman.

The incident was reported immediately at the Moremi Police Station in Ile Ife.

Members of the community who saw the bank's chief being kidnapped were said to have trailed the kidnappers on a motorcycle. The first vehicle the kidnappers used was said to have developed mechanical fault while another vehicle snatched at gunpoint to ferry their victim away also reportedly developed fault.

The abductors were said to have attempted to take Adeniji away on a motorbike but the prompt intervention of members of the public and the police thwarted their effort.

Policemen from the area office in Ile-Ife who had earlier been alerted were said to have trailed the kidnappers and killed two of them during a crossfire while others were arrested including a woman.

Commenting on the development, the state Commissioner of Police, Mrs. Helen Kalafite Adeyemi, confirmed the incident saying that it took men of the state command several hours to rescue the victim from the assailants.

She explained that information reached her office some minutes after the incident occurred and immediately she directed the Area Commander to ensure that the

kidnappers did not escape. Adeyemi noted that two of the kidnappers were killed during a crossfire while others were arrested.

She stressed that the arrested persons were assisting the police in their investigation, adding that the suspects would be arraigned immediately investigation on the matter was concluded.
