JTF Kills Two Boko Haram Suspects

THE Joint Task Force (JTF) in Borno State has killed two among the four Boko Haram suspects that killed five bankers in the Maiduguri metropolis last Thursday.

Two Kalashnikov rifles and 20 rounds of ammunition were also recovered from the suspects by the security task force, who carried out the operation in the wee hours of

Speaking on the killings via a telephone conversation yesterday, Field Operations Officer of JTF, Col. Victor Ebhaleme, confirmed that

the task force killed the suspects during a gunfire exchange.
