Gunmen kill DPO in Enugu

PALPABLE fear has gripped residents of Oji River Local Council of Enugu State followcouncil of Enugu State following the killing at the weekend of the Divisional Police Officer (DPO) of the council, Superintendent of Police, Okey Ofoedu, by unknown gunmen.

Ofoedu, who hailed from Anambra State, had headed the division in the last one year

division in the last one year. Sources said yesterday that the police officer was ambushed while on night patrol at about 8.00 p.m. by some unidentified

8.00 p.m. by some unidentified gunmen and hacked to death. His assailants reportedly pumped several bullets into their victim and abandoned him in the pool of his own blood beside his car where he breathed his last.

But the state Police Commissioner, Musa Daura, who confirmed the incident, said the DPO met his untimely death at Ojinator along Awka/Oji River old road by a filling station.
