## Man kills two in Calabar

TWO persons have been killed in Calabar, Cross River State following a wild attack by a suspected drug addict.

An eyewitness, who simply gave his name as Ekpo, said the suspected drug addict had

attacked a family at Mkpang Joseph Street in Ikot Ansa, Calabar and killed a woman with a machete and inflicted several machete cuts on four

children.

A daughter of one of the deceased persons, who gave her name as Glory, said: "The drug addict had attacked his brother who ran into our house for

refuge. But unable to reach his brother, the man attacked my mother, three others and me before he was overpowered. "The youths overpowered him and burnt him inside his house. His two houses were burnt and the uncompleted one pulled down." Glory said: "He came and forced our door opened and attacked us. My mother was rushed to the General Hospital but could not be attended to because the workers there were on strike and she died this morning due to too much bleeding.
