

TWO armed robbers allegedly terrorizing residents of Apapa and its environs in Lagos, have been killed by the police.

One locally made double barrel cut to size, two cartridges and one motorcycle were recovered from the hoodlums.

The police command tightened security in Lagos State after a bizarre attack by armed robbers last Sunday which claimed the lives of three policemen and a commercial bus driver.

dispossessed some people of cash and valuables at Coconut Bus stop area. The bandits also attempted to rob bank customers who were in Apapa to withdraw money for the weekend when they ran into the police team at Trebor Junction where they met their Waterloo.

The Lagos State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Ngozi Braide, who confirmed the incident to The Guardian said the Divisional Police Officer in Apapa Police Station, Usman Ndambabo led a team of policemen to some of the 'nipping' points in the area.
