Eight feared dead in Anambra road crashes

Local Council Area and lyienu-Ogidi in Idemili North Council Area of Anambra State were thrown into confu-

sion and mourning when two separate motor accidents claimed about eight lives on

Monday in their communities. Evewitness accounts said the

Umunya road crash occurred when a private Sports Utility Van had a head-on collision with a commuter bus, claiming about seven lives and leav-

ing several others injured. The Ivienu-Ogidi accident was said to have occurred along the old Onitsha to Enugu road, near the Ivienu

Hospital owned by the Anglican Church, claiming one life. When contacted, the Unit Commander of Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Nteje, in a telephone interview, confirmed both accidents, saying each happened at different

times of the day. But he said only two people were killed in both accidents.
