## Man knocked down by hit-and-run driver on Oshodi -Apapa Expressway

T was a gory sight yesterday at Five Star Bus Stop on Oshodi-Apapa Expressway, Lagos as the body of an unidentified young man, hit by a car, lay unattended to for several hours on the service lane.

It would take only the strong-willed to cast a second glance at the corpse of the man knocked down in the early hours of the day,

long before early callers began arriving the spot to get to Aswani Market, which opens every Tuesday.

By the time onlookers began milling round the body, it was already too late for any rescue effort, as the young man laid stone dead and stiff without any form of identity on him.

Some traders at Ladipo automobile market, however, identified the man as a hustler and cart pusher, who conveyed vehicle parts for buyers from the market.

An eyewitness, who narrated to *The Guardian* how the man met his death, said he crossed the expressway of using the pedestrian bridge at about 5.30a.m. and had successfully cross the road before strolling past the service lane unaware that an

oncoming vehicle, which rammed into him.

"I don't think he would have survived the incident even if help had come his way when it happened because he sustained a severe head injury and the vehicle dragged him on the ground for several metres."

Officials of the Lagos State Emergency Management Agency (LASEMA) later removed the body from the spot at 3.00p.m.
