

In Plateau, man kills daughter for rituals

A TWENTY-YEAR-OLD man in Bokkos Local Council of Plateau State, Polycarp Tagan, has confessed to killing his four-month-old daughter for money-making rituals.

Speaking to journalists yesterday when he was pa-

raded by the Plateau State Police Command, Tagan said he was consulted by a herbalist, now at large, to bring the tongue of his daughter so that he could be made rich.

According to Tagan: "Last week, I got home and when my wife was preparing supper for the family, I sneaked

into the room to commit the atrocity. Just after I had snuffed out life from her, my wife came into the room and saw me cutting off the tongue of my baby. She screamed and that attracted our villagers who, in turn, handed me over to the police."

He further said the love of

money pushed him into committing the crime.

Also paraded among nine others was one Mr. Fongno who was arrested for killing his two-year-old son in Mangu Local Council of Plateau for bed-wetting.
