Gunmen kill People, Destroy Houses In Borno

VIOLENCE has erupted again in Borno State, as gunmen suspected to be members of Boko Haram sect attacked Ngoshe town and killed about 14 people on Thursday.

The gunmen also destroyed a building housing Ekilisiyar Yan'uwa a Nigeria (EYN) church and 25 other houses with improvised explosive devices (IEDs) and petrol-bombs.

Ngoshe, a town of about 119 kilometres Southeast of Maiduguri, is a border community with Cameroon.

Spokesman of Borno State Police Command, Gideon Jibrin, who confirmed the incident, stated that no arrest was made in the Ngoshe killings.

According to an eyewitness, who spoke to The Guardian Friday in Maiduguri, the gunmen came in three Hilux vehicles armed with explosives, clashing with vigilante youths on patrol, before overpowering the latter to destroy property worthy of millions of naira, including 350 bags of grains and 250 livestock.
