

## Boko Haram Invade Adamawa, Kill Over Six People

IT was a scene of tears and bloodbath Thursday night in Adamawa State when suspected members of Boko Haram invaded Yola, the state capital, and killed over six persons, aside injuring several others.

The Guardian gathered that the insurgents took over control of the

Jimeta by-pass, which has one of the strongest military check points, at about 10 pm, and started shooting sporadically while moving from one house to another asking for the members of the civilian JTF.

According to a survivor, three of the civilian JTF members were killed during the operation carried out by the terrorists, who in their song, said they were battled ready to face the Federal Government.

Sources told The Guardian that police and other security agents arrived the scene of the incident an hour after the terrorists group left to an unknown hide out.

Unconfirmed report also revealed that the terrorists also carried out simultaneous operations in

other parts of the state.

When journalists stormed the office of 32 Amoured Brigade Commander, Brigadier-General Fatai Oladikpo Alli, to comment on the incident that attracted heavy protests from the Yola residents, he sent one of his soldiers to inform them that he was too busy to see newsmen for comments on the killings.
