ing the lives of a family of eight persons yesterday. It was alleged that armed men suspected to be Fulani herdsmen invaded Machok town and killed the said family of members in an early morning attack before disappearing into the thin air.

The incident was said to have provoked the youths

of Machok town, who mobilised and attacked a Fulani settlement close to the town.

However, the armed security personnel stationed in the area made frantic

effort to put the situation under control, while the incident escalated to a full scale communal violence. The gravity of the bloody clash forced the state Governor, Alhaji Mukhtar Ramalan Yero to abandon other state duties and

other state duties and headed straight to the scene to pacify the warring parties.

An eye witness, Mrs. Bulus Baicainta who spoke in an interview, said when the governor was busy

addressing the youths

and elders of the communities another attack was said to have been launched on a nearby village where several people were said to have lost their lives, saying that "it took the intervention of the military personnel and security attaché to the governor to bring the situation under control."
