THERE was pandemonium Friday at the Federal University of Petroleum Resources (FUPRE), Effurun, Delta State, as a final year Computer Science student identified as Jimoh Lateef was shot dead by gunman suspected to be from one of the two host communities.

The killing almost led to full blown reprisal attack by irate students but were dispersed by a team of police and army personnel deployed to the school
