WITH more alertness to safety practices, the late Seun Oguntaye may still be alive today. But his life was cut short at about 10.45am, Saturday, after the Lagos State monthly sanitisation exercise.

Oguntaye died of electrocution from a high voltage electric cable, when he made efforts to handover an iron rod to his colleagues, who stood on a scaffold, undergoing construction.

Until his death, he was among four artisans


The incident triggered a fire outbreak that drew sympathisers to the spot. Unfortunately, they could not do anything to save the life of Oguntaye.
