

Gunmen kill one in Katsina/Ala

AN armed gang on Saturday shot and killed one Amem Jabi at Takum Junction in Kastina/Ala Local Council of Benue State at about 8.00p.m.

Eye witnesses said the deceased was shot severally by the gunmen without carting away anything from anybody around, including the deceased before zooming off to an unknown destination.

Politicians have been blamed by residents of the town, which has recorded similar incidents in recent times.

Armed thugs now wreak havoc on innocent citizens who they perceive as their opponents in the 2015 poll.

Katsina/Ala, one of the councils in the state, is also reputed for violence given its proximity to Taraba State, which is currently under heavy attacks from Fulani insurgents.

The state police spokesman, Daniel Ezeala, an Assistant Superintendent of Police, said information about the incident was still sketchy, promising to call back for an update even as chairman of the local council, Mr. Martins Agir could not be reached for comments as he neither picked his calls nor replied text messages sent to him to that effect.
